Firstly, thank you for your continued support and cooperation with keeping our school as safe as possible. Please find highlighted below the latest updates and changes to our school's Risk Assessment. These changes are to continue to ensure that our school community is as safe as possible. As always, I would ask you to please read over and share with other members of your family who collect and drop off your child(ren) to school so they are also aware of the changes.

Updates to lunchtimes as of Monday 14th September 2020

- P1, P2 and P3 pupils have lunch in the hall from 12:30 to 13:00. They remain in the hall until 13:00. At 13:00 they go outside to play.
- P4, P5, P6 and P7 pupils go outside to play from 12:30 to 13:00. At 13:00 they have their lunch in the hall and remain in the hall until 13:30. At 13:30 they return to class.
- Classes have a designated table in the hall.
- Any pupils going home for lunch **should not return to school before 13:30.**

Updates to breaktimes as of Monday 14th September 2020

- P1 and P2/3 classes will have break from 10:30 to 10:45.
- P4/5 and P6/7 classes will have break from 10:45 to 11:00.
- If weather does not allow an outdoor playtime, classes remain in their classrooms for breaktime.

Building Ventilation

As you are aware the weather is starting to turn, and we are heading into cooler months. You are also aware, that windows in the school are required to stay open to ensure a fresh flow of air. Therefore, pupils should make sure they have a couple of extra layers of clothing with them which they can take off or put on if they feel they need to in school. For example, thermal vest or similar or a body warmer. The Authority has turned on the heating, but we do find some days we are competing with the wind from the North Sea!
