

Good luck to all the pupils representing our school.


HWB (HEALTH AND WELLBEING)

P6/7 class will be performing their show, 'The Wizard of Oz' as a Café event on Friday 23rd June at 9.30am.




CAFÉ TICKET ALLOCATION
