SHARING OUR LEARNING

Parents/carers are invited to school between 2.30pm and 3.30pm on Friday 8th March.

This hour drop in session is to invite parents/carers to visit their child(s) classroom and look at their child(s) learning. Pupils will be the 'tour guide' for their learning area and will be showing visitors their work displayed around the school, in their classroom and in jotters and curricular folders.

This open afternoon is not an opportunity to discuss individual pupil progress. Reports and parent consultations are organised for term 4 where parents/carers will be able to discuss progress with the class teacher confidentially.

STAFF ARE LEARNING TOO!

With the delivery of three new Smartboards to enrich learning, staff and pupils will be taking part in SmartBoard training this session delivered by IT. Pupils will be able to engage in a session with IT colleagues and staff will then continue as part of our CLPL.

Mrs Cormack, Ms Christie, Ms McDonald and Miss Wells have recently completed Talk for Writing sessions which aim to develop the teaching of writing in Early years to P3. Staff are now engaged in Talk for Writing sessions for P4 to P7 stages.

P7 TRANSITION

As part of Mackie transition events, P7 pupils have engaged in a Literacy lesson delivered by English teachers from Mackie. They will be completing their critical essay lesson next week.

Houses for Mackie have been shared with pupils and sent home. If any family wishes to discuss any aspect of the house their child has been placed, please feel free to contact Mackie Academy.

Literacy jotters have been shared with our P7s. These jotters are used in primary and continue to be used for Literacy in S1 at Mackie. The jotters allow English staff at Mackie to see the work produced at Primary and help to build relationships with staff and pupils from early on.

PSAT staff from Mackie will be visiting our P7s in term 4. This is an informal visit where staff can meet the pupils who will be their in house at Mackie and for P7 pupils to start to get to know their PSAT before they go to Mackie.

Our ASN teacher, Mrs Crowe is also our link teacher with Mackie again this year. Mrs Crowe is able to meet with all P7s and answer questions they may have about Mackie. Mrs Crowe is also able to ensure pupil information is shared with staff at Mackie and is again another staff member that P7s know before they start at Mackie in August.

GENTLE REMINDERS

Pupils will be bringing home their indoor shoes in the Easter holidays. Could parents please check the condition of them and replace if necessary. Several of pupil's indoor shoes have Velcro that no longer fastens and could be a safety issue for them and to other pupils.
